COURSE DESCRIPTION: The purpose of Bible is to acquaint and familiarize the student with basic knowledge of Bible characters, events, and principles. The primary purpose is to bring the students to knowledge of the need for Jesus Christ as personal Savior and then acting upon that knowledge.

GOALS AND OBJECTIVES:

Goal 1: To increase knowledge of Bible characters (Adam, Noah, Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Joseph, David, Solomon, Jesus, Peter, and Paul)

- 1.1 The student will describe places in the story of a particular Bible character.
- 1.2 The student will describe events in the story of a particular Bible character.
- 1.3 The student will describe themes in the story of a particular Bible character.
- 1.4 The student will describe other characters in the story of a particular Bible character.
- 1.5 The student will answer written comprehension questions.
- 1.6 The student will match pictures concerning a particular Bible character.

Goal 2: To develop an understanding of salvation and heaven

- 2.1 The student will make a choice to accept or reject Jesus Christ as Savior when given the oral Bible lesson concerning heaven.
- 2.2 The student will make a choice to accept or reject Jesus Christ as Savior when given the oral Bible lesson concerning the beginning of sin.
- 2.3 The student will make a choice to accept or reject Jesus Christ as Savior when given the oral Bible lesson concerning the crucifixion and resurrection of Christ.
- 2.4 The student will make a choice to accept or reject Jesus Christ as Savior when given the oral Bible lesson containing a clear presentation of salvation.
- 2.5 The student will describe characteristics of heaven.

Goal 3: To understand the days of creation

- 3.1 The student will describe the days of creation.
- 3.2 The student will place flashcards of the days of creation in order.

Goal 4: To increase knowledge of the birth, life, ministry, miracles, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ

- 4.1 The student will describe the people, places, events, and themes involved in the Bible stories concerning the birth of Jesus Christ.
- 4.2 The student will describe the people, places, events, and themes involved in the Bible stories concerning the life and ministry of Jesus Christ.
- 4.3 The student will describe the people, places, events, and themes involved in the Bible stories concerning the miracles of Jesus Christ.
- 4.4 The student will describe the people, places, events, and themes involved in the Bible stories concerning the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

Goal 5: To realize the importance of daily prayer

- 5.1 The student will share his or her prayer requests with the class throughout the year.
- 5.2 The student will share his or her praises with the class throughout the year.
- 5.3 The student will verbalize his or her own prayer with the class throughout the year.
- 5.4 The student will develop a personal prayer time.

- 6.18 The student will recite Exodus 20:3-4, 7-8, 12-17.
- 6.19 The student will recite Romans 3:23.
- 6.20 The student will locate a given verse in the Bible.

Goal 7: To memorize the books of the Bible

- 7.1 The student will quote the books of the Old Testament in order.
- 7.2 The student will quote the books of the New Testament in order.
- 7.3 The student will state the number of books in the Old Testament as 39, the number of books in the New Testament as 27, and the total number of books in the Bible as 66.

Goal 8: To develop an ability to demonstrate appropriate behavior in chapel services.

- 8.1 The student will participate in chapel services by singing and praying.
- 8.2 The student will sit quietly and give attention to the chapel speaker while the Bible story is presented.

Goal 9: To participate in song time.

- 9.1 The student will sing songs that teach theology.
- 9.2 The student will sing songs that teach character.

Goal 10: To develop an understanding of the history of Thanksgiving

- 10.1 The student will share things for which he or she is thankful.
- 10.2 The student will make crafts pertaining to Thanksgiving.
- 10.3 The student will describe the blessings of God in his or her life.
