

# MUSIC GOALS & OBJECTIVES

TEXTBOOK: Music 1

- Goal 1: The student will sing and perform, alone and with others, a varied repertoire of music.
- 1.1 The student will match pitch using the head voice.
  - 1.2 The student will perform rhythms using quarter notes, quarter rests, and beamed eighth notes.
  - 1.3 The student will demonstrate slow and fast tempi through movement.
  - 1.4 The student will demonstrate strong and weak beats through movement.
- Goals 2: The student will listen to, analyze, and describe music.
- 2.1 The student will read beamed eighth notes, quarter notes and rests.
  - 2.2 The student will notate Sol-Mi.
