

# **BIBLE**

**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** This Bible course introduces students to the sovereign power of God. It continues to teach the students Who God is and what He expects from them as they grow in their Christian life.

## **GOALS & OBJECTIVES:**

### **Goal 1: To realize that God rules creation**

- 1.1 The student will describe the ways God has ruled creation since the beginning of time.
- 1.2 The student will list the days of creation.
- 1.3 The student will describe the day of rest.

### **Goal 2: To appreciate that God rules nature**

- 2.1 The student will retell the events of the flood.
- 2.2 The student will describe how Noah found grace in God's eyes.
- 2.3 The student will list the ways God provided for Noah and his family in the ark.
- 2.4 The student will quote God's promise illustrated by the rainbow.

### **Goal 3: To comprehend that God rules families**

- 3.1 The student will describe the events of the tower of Babel.
- 3.2 The student will name Abram as the father of the nation of Israel.

### **Goal 4: To realize that God should control their actions**

- 4.1 The student will describe the use of obedient feet through the Bible account of Moses.
- 4.2 The student will list ways that God can control the things that they look at.
- 4.3 The student will articulate appropriate speech with their tongues.
- 4.4 The student will use their hands to glorify God.

### **Goal 5: To develop an understanding of a humble heart**

- 5.1 The student will prove that there is only one God.
- 5.2 The student will describe ways to humble themselves before God.
- 5.3 The student will apply concepts of walking in the spirit of humility.

### **Goal 6: To appreciate the birth of the Savior**

- 6.1 The student will describe the foretelling of Christ's birth.
- 6.2 The student will reenact Christ's birth.
- 6.3 The student will retell the story of Christ's birth.
- 6.4 The student will memorize Luke 2.

**Goal 7: To demonstrate acts of service to God**

- 7.1 The student will describe the Biblical servants that knew God.
- 7.2 The student will list ways to serve God in love.
- 7.3 The student will describe ways that God can use them.
- 7.4 The student will apply ways that God wants them to work together.

**Goal 8: To expand on the ways God gives courage**

- 8.1 The student will describe ways to use courage to serve God.
- 8.2 The student will apply using courage during hard times.
- 8.3 The student will show courage to speak God's Word.
- 8.4 The student will practice living Godly through courage.

**Goal 9: To comprehend a forgiving heart**

- 9.1 The student will share their need of forgiveness.
- 9.2 The student will describe God's forgiveness to them.
- 9.3 The student will accept God's forgiveness.
- 9.4 The student will practice forgiving others.

**Goal 10: To comprehend that Jesus is the Messiah**

- 10.1 The student will demonstrate that Jesus is God through His miracles.
- 10.2 The student will describe how Jesus was man on earth.
- 10.3 The student will state that Jesus is the Savior of men.
- 10.4 The student will tell that Jesus is the King of King.

**Goal 11: To understand the concept of a generous heart**

- 11.1 The student will interpret ways to give himself or herself to God.
- 11.2 The student will state things that God has given to them.
- 11.3 The student will explain how to give possessions to God.
- 11.4 The student will state ways they give themselves to others.
