- 5.3 The student will explain how Jesus gives victory over Satan.

- 6.2 The student will explain how God put them in their family.
- 6.3 The student will determine that God gives them what they have.
- 6.4 The student will explain how God will take care of their future.

- 8.7 The student will describe Jesus crucifixion and death.
- 8.8 The student will describe Jesus' burial and resurrection.

Goal 9: To learn about the function of the church in the life of a Christian.
