

MUSIC

TEXT: *Music 4 for Christian Schools*
Music Theory 2

Goal 1: To sing and perform, alone and with others, a varied repertoire of music.

- 1.1 The student will sing songs based on major scales.
- 1.2 The student will sing in a three-part round.
- 1.3 The student will accompany singing on a variety of classroom instruments.
- 1.4 The student will play I and V chords in a major key.
- 1.5 The student will perform rhythmic and melodic patterns to add special effects to songs.
- 1.6 The student will perform music containing *crescendo* and *decrescendo*.
- 1.7 The student will demonstrate rondo form through movement.
- 1.8 The student will demonstrate *moderato* and *andante* through movement.

Goal 2: To listen, analyze, and describe music.

- 2.1 The student will expand previously learned notation to include single eighth notes and rests.
- 2.2 The student will read notation containing syncopated patterns.
- 2.3 The student will identify and demonstrate *D.S.*
- 2.4 The student will notate/manipulate a major scale.
- 2.5 The student will notate whole note and whole rest.
- 2.6 The student will notate tonic and dominant chords.
- 2.7 The student will identify aurally and visually instruments of the orchestra.
- 2.8 The student will identify rondo form.
- 2.9 The student will identify *andante* and *moderato*.
- 2.10 The student will evaluate their own musical performances.

Goal 3: To compose and arrange music.

- 3.1 The student will improvise rhythmic questions and answers.
- 3.2 The student will create a song in rondo form.

Goal 4: To understand relationships between music, the other arts, and disciplines outside the arts.

- 4.1 The student will dramatize and create music for a work of visual art.
- 4.2 The student will identify and discuss tone production for instruments.
- 4.3 The student will recognize selections from musical theatre.
- 4.4 The student will sing patriotic songs.
