

BIBLE

COURSE DESCRIPTION: The purpose of this course is to teach the students to know Christ as their personal savior, desire to know more about Him and how to obey Him more, and to serve Him in the future.

TEXTBOOK: *Bible Truths 5: Living in God's Love*

GOALS & OBJECTIVES:

Goal 1: To understand that the Bible is God's Word

- 1.1 The student will realize that Bible accounts are fact.
- 1.2 The student will realize that the Bible is the final authority in all decisions.

Goal 2: To recognize their need of Christ as personal Savior

- 2.1 The student will comprehend God's dealings with His people and their individual need of salvation.
- 2.2 The student will share the plan of salvation with others in the class in order to do the same in their everyday lives.

Goal 3: To Increase Christ likeness in the students

- 3.1 The student will compare application stories to which behaviors please and displease God.
- 3.2 The student will list steps of Christian obedience that follow salvation.

Goal 4: To know more about God

- 4.1 The student will apply things learned about the Bible as well as the God of it.
- 4.2 The student will answer discussion questions after each Bible lesson is given.
- 4.3 The student will list attributes of God.
- 4.4 The student will read passages and write reasons for God's grace and mercy.

Goal 5: To apply Bible knowledge to their daily lives

- 5.1 The student will memorize scripture passages weekly.
- 5.2 The student will list ways that God's Word has relevance in every part of their lives.
- 5.3 The student will make a pamphlet explaining salvation and try to share with another person.

Goal 6: To develop the practicing of Bible skills

- 6.1 The student will search using cross-references, concordances, and a Bible dictionary.
- 6.2 The student will find information and interpret meanings using their Bibles.

Goal 7: To connect Bible events with historical events

- 7.1 The student will outline background information to provide a broader knowledge of Bible times.
- 7.2 The student will read stories about noted Christians in history.

Goal 8: To use the book “The Lion, The Witch, and The Wardrobe” along with the Bible to find illustrations of God and make application to daily living.

- 8.1 The student will read weekly chapters searching for symbolism about God.
- 8.2 The student will take notes on current issues as they read the book.
- 8.3 The student will search the scriptures to reinforce what God has to say about issues.
