GOALS AND OBJECTIVES:

Goal 1: To become familiar with the person of Jesus

- 1.1 The student will retell the story of Jesus Christ's birth.
- 1.2 The student will list several miracles Jesus Christ performed.
- 1.3 The student will retell the story of Jesus Christ's death.
- 1.4 The student will retell the story of Jesus Christ's resurrection.
- 1.5 The student will recite doctrines within the daily drill session.
- 1.6 The student will explain the significance of the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ.
- 1.7 The student will orally answer questions concerning the deity, authority, and power of Jesus, God's son.
- 1.8 The student will recite from memory John 3:16.
- 1.9 The student will recite from memory Romans 3:23.
- 1.10 The student will recite from memory Acts 16:31.
- 1.11 The student will recite from memory John 14:6.
- 1.12 The student will recite from memory Isaiah 45:22.

Goal 2: To recognize God as the Creator of all things

- 2.1 The student will retell the story of creation.
- 2.2 The student will cut, color and make a booklet on the seven days of creation.
- 2.3 The student will recite from memory Exodus 20:8.

Goal 3: To develop love for God's Word

- 3.1 The student will give examples of God's provision and protection after listening to Bible Stories about Joseph, Noah, Enoch, Abraham & Isaac.
- 3.2 The student will recite from memory Isaiah 43:5.
- 3.3 The student will recite from memory 1 John 4:8.
- 3.4 The student will recite from memory 2 Peter 1:4.

Goal 4: To desire to love God and talk to Him in prayer

- 4.1 The student will recite from memory the Lord's Prayer.
- 4.2 The student will recite from memory Psalm 100.
- 4.3 The student will lead the class in prayer.
- 4.4 The student will list five ways to grow spiritually.
- 4.5 The student will orally answer questions about how God specifically answered prayer during Bible story time.
- 4.6 The student will recite from memory John 14:14.
- 4.7 The student will recite from memory Psalm 118:1.
- 4.8 The student will recite from memory Psalm 147:10.
- 4.9 The student will recite from memory Psalm 75:1.
- 4.10 The student will recite from memory John 16:23.

Goal 5: To show love for the Lord through behavior

- 5.1 The student will correctly identify and color a picture of godly behavior.
- 5.2 The student will orally give examples of godly behavior.
- 5.3 The student will orally answer questions concerning right choices and consequences of wrong choices.
- 5.4 The student will recite from memory Ephesians 6:1.
- 5.5 The student will recite from memory Psalm 34:14.
- 5.6 The student will recite from memory Proverbs 20:11.
- 5.7 The student will recite from memory Exodus 20:12.
- 5.8 The student will recite from memory Psalm 34:14.
- 5.9 The student will recite from memory Matthew 6:24.
- 5.10 The student will recite from memory Genesis 16:13.
