

Radio Broadcast Project



The students will be researching a person or event from the 1920's, recording their voice by reading their information into a recorder, and recording facts from all of the research from the entire class.

This project has 3 parts:

1. Individual research
2. Recording of research through voice recording
3. Listing facts from the entire playback of all research from the class

Process: Students will pick a name "out of the hat" and research using books from the library and internet. The students will answer questions from a prepared information sheet from the teacher. From that sheet, the student will write their script about their person the 1920's to record on a recorder. They can make it funny or just like a "news break." Once all recordings have been made, all students will write one fact from each person represented as the "project is "broadcasted" back to the students. This is an in-class project, but students can print off research from home to bring to class!

Points: 75
