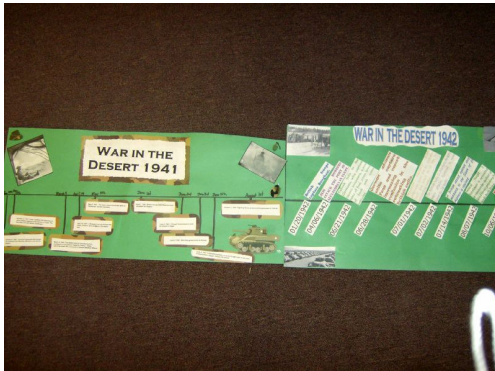


## Timeline Project



**Dates:** Assignments given March 8<sup>th</sup> and project turned in March 30<sup>th</sup>!

**Project:** Students will be given a section of the War and will research that timeframe and place facts on the time line that are most important. Once the students bring in their piece of their timeline, we will put all of the timelines together and have a complete timeline of the War! Information should be typed and pasted to the board! Please do not change the background of the board.

- \_ They must include at least 10 facts and 2 pictures!
- \_ Labeling the time of the timeline should be done in bold and centered.
- \_ Sources should be recorded on the back of the poster.
- \_ The facts should be close to what we have studied (nothing too crazy!)

**Details:** We will focus our timelines on the War in Europe and in the Pacific. Students will be given the timeframe to research on March 11<sup>th</sup>. A prepared piece of poster board will be given to each child with a marked line for the timeline. Students can use stickers, pictures, etc. to make their board more creative! ## Battle Presentations
