

The High School Art Elective 2011-2012

Course Description

This course is designed for any student, no matter his or her artistic ability. The class will expose students to different medium, encourage creativity, and teach the basics of Art Theory and Art History.

Required Supplies

Artwork – 3 Pieces due every quarter (100 Points per assignment)
Sketchpad – 6 sketches due every Friday class meets (60 Points per assignment)
P.O.P. Art Report – Brief Summaries of an Artist or of a Famous Work of Art (50 Points per Assignment)
Teaching an Art Lecture – 5 min. (100 Points per assignment)
