

K3-K5 Dress Code

Effective August 21, 2008

General Guidelines:

- Style of shoe is optional, but closed-toed shoes and socks are always the best option for safety reasons. If a child cannot tie his or her own shoes, please purchase shoes with Velcro.
- If a child wears a belt, he or she must be able to open and close the belt without the teacher's help.
- Parents must bring a change of clothing that can be kept at the school in case of emergency. Remember to send a winter time set once the cold weather starts.
- Students may not wear clothing imprinted with questionable messages, symbols, and pictures. (i.e. Hannah Montana, Bratz, High School Musical)
- No Camouflage
- Make sure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather. Do not send your child without a coat in the winter.

Boys:

Collared shirts, tee shirts, or sweatshirts may be worn. Little boys may wear shorts and dress or casual pants.

Girls:

Little girls may wear dresses or skirts with blouses, t-shirts, sweatshirts or sweaters. Shorts, skorts, pants or capris may also be worn. Sundresses or jumpers with thin straps must be worn with a blouse or jacket. Girls are not to wear midriffs or miniskirts. Shorts and skorts are to be no higher than two inches above the knee. If wearing a skirt or dress, shorts must be worn underneath.

Cold Weather Dress:

If the temperature is below 70 degrees, students must bring a light weight jacket, sweatshirt, or coat to school. Gloves, scarves, and hats with strings may not be worn for safety reasons. If the weather is too cold, the students will remain inside for recess.
